

Job Summary:

Using a parent educational model in the Early Intervention program and a client educational model in our Capability Kids clinic, a Physical Therapist will help the client develop or regain physical or mental functioning by implementing programs to improve motor delays, conditions and other issues. The Physical Therapist performs other administrative duties as may be required in support of the program goals and objectives.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- · Develops ideas, plans, and procedures for initiation, expansion, improvement, and evaluation of therapy programs.
- · Completes initial evaluations and re-evaluations for patients in the program; examines the condition of patients and analyzes their needs; determines the need for a physical therapy evaluation and selects and administers appropriate assessment tools to evaluate the patient.
- · Prepares reports and attends multidisciplinary case meeting to decide and review the continuing treatment.

- · Participates in continuing education for professional development to ensure practice consistent with best practice and to meet Nevada Licensure requirements.
- · Participates in bi-monthly staff meetings; attends staff trainings.
- · Attends Staff Trainings
- · Case assignment will be dictated at the discretion of Capability Health needs in the Early Intervention and outpatient clinic programs.
- · Manages patients with different types of personalities
- · Interprets evaluation data and writes comprehensive reports that reflect strengths and barriers to client participation; directs program development; and guides evidence-based intervention.
- · Uses professional Code of Ethics and standards of practice to guide ethical decision making in practice.
- · Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

- · Initial certification by National Board for Physical Therapy required.
- · Current Physical Therapy License from the State of Nevada required.
- · Minimum of two (2) years of experience working with children using knowledge of treatment practices per discipline required.
- · CPR and First Aid certifications required.
- · Valid driver's license required.
- · Knowledge of the federal, state local legislation, regulations, policies and procedures that mandate and guide physical therapy in practice required.
- · Proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite (Word and Excel) required.
